



CSCB Safeguarding Learning and Development – Child Neglect

Who is this course for?

Professionals and volunteers with safeguarding responsibilities who work regularly with children, young people and/or their parents/carers, or have a period of irregular but intense contact.

Learning Aims and Objectives

The CSCB is keen to help practitioners develop their knowledge, skills and behaviour to help prevent and support children at risk of neglect. To ensure that they are effectively protected from harm of neglect a robust and coordinated multi-agency intervention and support approach needs to be in place. Neglect is a feature in many families who safeguarding professionals work with and yet it is so hard for professionals to create successful interventions that turn it around. This course will explore why it is important to be analytical about neglect and will challenge current professional thinking with neglect. There will be a focus on effective multi agency interventions that create change for children and young people.

- Gain knowledge about types of neglect
- Understand why neglect is complex and how to analyse neglect
- Develop new skills and models for working with parents/carers to improve on their parenting to 'hold their child in mind'
- Use of multi-agency meetings to inform and improve planning and interventions
- Develop ideas for creative plans that make a difference to children's lives
- Use tools for analysis to understand child's lived experience
