Who is this course for?

For all professionals and volunteers who regularly work with children, young people and/or their parents/carers - or have a period of irregular but intense contact. Practitioners need to be aware of the risks of Domestic Abuse and the impact on babies, children and young people within the home.

Learning Objectives

All practitioners working with, and on behalf of, children, young people and families have responsibility for ensuring everything possible is done to prevent the unnecessary escalation of issues or problems. The right help at the right time is important, and this can often be when concerns are first identified.

- Effectively and confidently work with child and family to assess unmet needs
- Understand when an Early Help Assessment is needed
- Introduce the Locality Early Help team to you and the support they can provide to you
- Analysis of needs and co-ordination of multi-agency plan where required
- Planning and reviewing effectively with the family and multi-agency team
