- Receive up-to-date and relevant information on drugs of concern, including 'new psychotic substances'.
- Gain an understanding of local patterns of young people's use of both legal and illegal substances
- Understand more about engaging young people in dialogues about drugs and alcohol
- Gain knowledge and application of the Drug Use Screening Tool.
