## GIRLS! GIRLS! GIRLS!



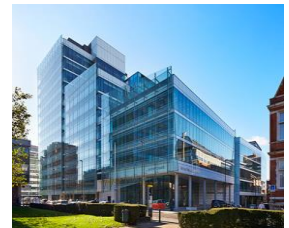
**WHAT?:** Croydon's Young People's Service & Croydon Child & Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS) have found that girls from Asian-British backgrounds do not access help for their mental health in Croydon and we hope to understand the reasons for this.

**WHO & WHEN?:** We are looking for up to **8** girls aged 14- years -17 years & 11 months old who **identify as Asian-British**, to volunteer in a discussion group, to answer questions on the topic. We require you to:

- Be able to speak English fluently
- Both your parents to identify as either: **Indian, Pakistani, Bangladeshi, Sri Lankan, Sinhalese or Tamil.**

This discussion group will take place on **17th January 2018** from 17:00pm – 18:00pm at the Croydon Council Building. Food will be provided during the discussion group.
